Working closely with the Controller and Director of Finance, the Senior Accountant supports smooth financial operations and to prepare all financial components of the fiscal sponsorship platform. The Senior Accountant ensures that all income and expenses are recorded in compliance with State and Federal guidelines, laws, and regulations.

Experience: Three (3) years' experience working in accounting position, Non-profit Audit & Accounting experience greatly preferred
