- Complete accident/incident forms if needed.

Minimum requirements

- At least 1-2 years of experience working with children.
- Must have a passion for working with children, and the development of their whole child.
- Have strong character, live the values of Pure Game, and be a positive role model in the lives of the children with who you interact.
- Have a fun-loving personality with the ability to demonstrate love and care through your actions.
- Demonstrate success through accepting responsibility for your actions.
- Must be able to lift up to 20 pounds.
- Must be able to walk, run, jump, and stand for long periods of time.
- Must be able to withstand extensive heat and cold temperatures.
- Availability primarily 2-6pm.
- Transportation to programs.
