POSITION TITLE: Health Educator (Youth Making Proud Choices)
REPORTS TO: Associate Director of Youth & Family Clinical Services

BASIC FUNCTION - Under the direction of the Associate Director, provide assistance to Youth Making Proud Choices Coordinator in comprehension sexual education program sessions.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Plan and facilitate comprehensive sexual teen health education groups using the Making Proud Choices curriculum.
2. Collect and analyze data to learn about community needs and program improvement.
3. Utilize Motivational Interviewing, trauma informed and strength-based approaches to develop a positive rapport and seek behavioral change with youth.
4. Offer case management support by assisting youth in making healthy choices, goals for their future, accountability for their actions and provide resources in the community.
5. Assist with community awareness messaging and recruitment via outreach events and social media.
6. Attend community network meetings to advocate for improved health resources for adolescent youth and their families.
7. Attend all mandatory staff trainings and grant training requirements.
8. Attend staff meetings and group supervision.
9. Abide by the professional code of conduct, including professional confidentiality guidelines and follow state reporting mandates.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Associate/Bachelor degree or in a program from an accredited university in Human Services, Social Work, Public Health, Sociology or related field and a minimum of six months working with youth.
2. Knowledge of comprehensive sexual health that includes HIV/AIDS/ STI and teen pregnancy prevention, is a plus.
3. Excellent verbal/written communication.
4. Knowledge of case management model is a plus.

ADDITIONAL POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be willing to work afternoon hours (2pm-5pm). Some evenings hours as needed.
2. Willing to work with adolescents ages 11-18 and their families. The majority of our families are low-income, Spanish-speaking families. Bilingual in Spanish is preferred.
3. Looking for someone who can work both independently and as a member of a team with excellent time management.

Benefits - Full-time 40 hours per week position. Annual salary is \$43,680 (\$21 per hour) health and dental insurance provided and a 403b retirement plan.
