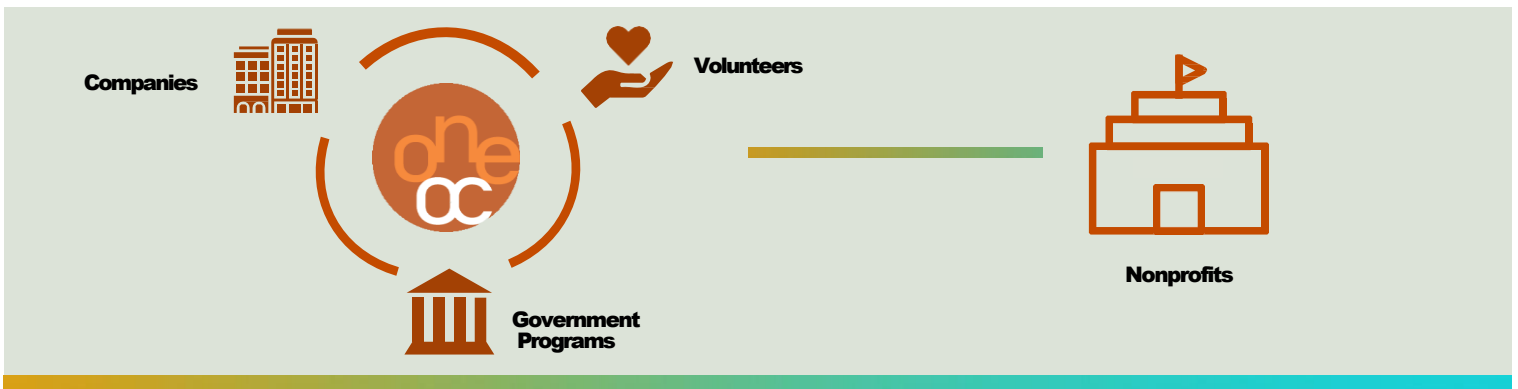


OUR MISSION

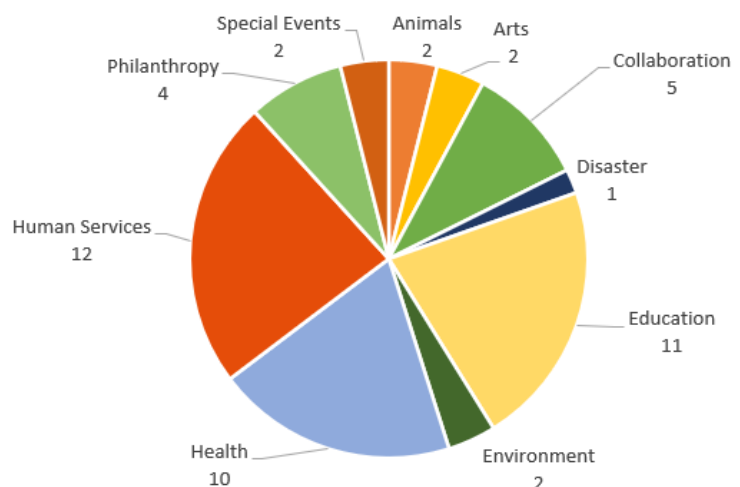

In 2022 OneOC received the largest fiscal sponsorship funding commitment in its history when Orange County Center for Innovation & Social Enterprise (OCCISE), a fiscal project of OneOC, was awarded an \$8.5 Million contract secured by California Senator Josh Newman from the State Of California for the NorthSTAR OC Collaborative.

In conjunction with OCCISE, NorthSTAR OC Collaborative was formed by RevHubOC to design and build a social entrepreneurship ecosystem in North Orange County to provide every element of support to social innovators from the earliest stages through full-fledged, viable social businesses, creating regional jobs and opportunity and providing a roadmap to expansion of such efforts across the region, state, and nation.
